55 BRAKE BOOSTER

AS SOME OF YOU KNOW I HAVE BEEN TRYIN TO WORK THROUGH SOME BRAKE ISSUES ON OUR 56. I SUP-POSE BECAUSE I'M USED TO MODERN CARS WITH UPDATED BRAKING SYS-TEMS THE STANDARD DRUM BRAKES ON THE TBIRD JUST DON'T CUT IT FOR ME. EVENTUALLY I WOULD LIKE TO INSTALL DISC BRAKES AT LEAST UP FRONT BUT I JUST HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO BRING MYSELF TO PULL THE TRIGGER FOR THE \$1000+ SET UP.

LAST YEAR I STARTED COLLECTING SOME PARTS FOR THE UPGRADE TO POWER DISC. I BOUGHT A 9" DUAL DIAPHRAM BOOSTER BUT WHEN I GOT THAT THEY PLUMBED INTO VACUUM HOME IT WAS IMMEDIATELY OBVIOUS THAT UNLESS I WANTED TO RECON-FIGURE A GREAT MANY THINGS, IT WAS NOT GOING TO FIT.
